Football code of conduct for players

- 1 Play because you enjoy football, not to please your parents or coach.
- 2 You must respect the rights, dignity and worth of each and every person and treat all equally within the context of the sport.
- 3 You must adhere to all guidelines laid down by the constitution and the code of conduct by the club.
- 4 You must develop an appropriate working relationship with the coach/manager based on mutual trust and respect.
- 5 You must accept responsibility for your own behaviour and performance and **do not** argue with the referee or their assistants.
- 6 You should at the outset, clarify with the coach/manager (and where appropriate your parents) exactly what is expected of you and also what you are entitled to expect from them and other players.
- 7 You must co-operate fully with specialists (eg, other coaches, officials, sports scientists, doctors, physiotherapists) in your own interest.
- 8 You must always adhere to the positive aspects of the sport (eg. Fair play) and never condone violations of the laws of the game, behaviour contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules and regulations or the use of prohibited substances or techniques.
- 9 You must consistently display high standards of behaviour.
- 10 You must appreciate the importance of striving to win, not winning itself.
